God has delivered our enemies into our hands - Gen. 14:20

This is an established fact as well as a promise. God delivered Abraham's enemies into his hands. Jesus has also defeated our enemies for us and has delivered them into our hands. Below are some enemies that have been delivered into our hands:

- 1. Satan is our enemy (Matt. 13:39; James 4:7): Yet, he can do us no harm because Jesus has defeated him and delivered him into our hands. though he may attack, he can only do as much harm as we allow him.
- 2. Sin is our enemy (1 John 3:8; Rom. 6:12-13). Sin is present in the world and even in our flesh, but we do not have to let it reign over us for we have been delivered from it's power.
- 3. Sickness and disease are our enemies (Matt. 8:17; Acts 10:38): Contrary to some beliefs, the Bible does not have one good thing to say about sickness nor disease. Therefore we have no business accepting anything into our lives that is not good and especially when it has been defeated.
- 4. Death is an enemy (1 Cor. 15:25-26; Rom. 6:9; Heb. 2:14): We have overcome both spiritual and physical death. You have eternal life right now if you are born again. We are not promised to live in this physical body forever and neither should we want to with it's weaknesses. However we need not fear physical death and we do not have to let it take us at a premature age. we should be able to live out a full life.
- 5. Unforgiveness is an enemy (Mark 11:25-26): It blocks faith and the answers to prayer. It causes strife in the church. Yet it is a conquered enemy, keep it that way in your life.
- 6. demons are enemies (Matt. 12:22-30): They are emissaries to satan and defeated enemies to us.
- 7. Ignorance is an enemy (Hosea 4:6): It destroys. Yet God's Word is made available so that it does not have to do it's work.
- 8. Poverty is an enemy (Deut. 28): Like sickness and disease, there is nothing in the Bible that glorifies poverty. It is called a curse and that makes it an enemy. Yet we have been redeemed from it (Gal. 3:13-14).
- 9. Fruitlessness is an enemy (John 15:1-8): Never winning a soul or making any progress for the Lord is not good, but it can be overcome when we realized it has been overcome in Jesus.
- 10. Doubt and unbelief are enemies (Numbers 13-14; James 1:5-7; Rom. 10:9-10): These enemies will keep you from all that God has for you. But you can keep them from preventing you from appropriating all that you have in Christ.

All these enemies and others have been delivered into your hands. By faith claim this promise and you will see all of your enemies dropped from your hands and placed under your feet.
